Regular Meeting Minutes of September 10, 2018 Bainville Town Council

The Regular meeting of the Bainville Town Council was called to order at 7:05 p.m. by Mayor Dennis Portra at the Bainville Town Hall, 211 Clark Avenue East. Lyle Lambert, Public Works, gave the following report:

- Culvert on Flynn by Clarence DeTienne's—Public Works worked on filling in the washout around the big culvert at the 'Y' on Flynn.
- Jetting Sewers—An issue with the sewer lines between Rhea Avenue and Flynn Avenue between Tubman Street and Evans Street, it appears that there are two 90-degree elbows in the sewer line and the Jet trailer is having a tough time getting through the corners.
- Sewer Oder—Public Works is aware of the foul oder coming from the Lagoons. A call into the MRWS to see what can be done and it appears the town is not the only town dealing with a fall rollover.
- Park water is still on until a company comes to winterize the lines
- One new Park Light is up and the other two will be installed in the coming days.
- New Locator—Maggie—The old magnetic locator is no longer able to locate anything, so the department ordered a new locator.
- Install Culvert The Public Works department installed a new culvert at Nobles at 611 Evans street.
