# Regular Meeting Minutes of March 14, 2019 Bainville Town Council

**The Regular meeting** of the Bainville Town Council was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Mayor Dennis Portra at the Bainville Town Hall, 211 Clark Avenue East. Present were: Ron Butikofer, Dennis Portra and Scott Ross. Mandy Hickel was absent. A **quorum** was established. Also present were Clerk, Nikki Rogers; Public Works Director, Lyle Lambert; Absent was City Attorney, Greg Hennessey. Guests included: Bernie Popp, Joe Popp, Mike Elkouz, Cora Norton, Dana Salivar, Diane Panasuk.

Scott Ross moved to approve the agenda with addition of old business Letter D. Truck Parking. Ron Butikoker seconded the motion. All voted in favor and motion carried.

Scott Ross moved to approve the minutes dated January 17, 2019 as submitted. Ron Butikofer seconded the motion. All voted in favor and motion carried.

#### Public Comment

- A. Website Complaint regarding noise from Smokey's Council discussed the complaint regarding the noise from Smokey's at 11:00 PM. The Roosevelt County Sheriff's office was call and responded.
- B. Unsigned complaint regarding receptionist job requirements

  - Mr. Popp also asked if it is feasible to get a trestle over the BNSF tracks. Mayor Portra stated it would be extremely unlikely the state and BNSF would do anything to fix the blocked crossings.

#### Public Works Report

Lyle Lambert, Public Works, gave the following report:

- Neptune Installation:
  - All meters were installed except about eight which when spring comes, they will need to be dug up.
- New meter for the Bainville School was ordered, received and installed.
- Mancamp—Surveyor and Engineering firms have been doing some work on the property and inquired on the as built drawings.
- Sewer Issues at 106 7th Avenue East—Mr. Lambert introduced Mike Elkouz who is having frozen sewer issues. Mr. Lambert indicated the line is frozen about 2ft from the Main. Mayor Portra with the consent of the Council directed Public Works to hire someone to fix and clean out the Main.
- The new Bobcat and Toolcat are on order and will be delivered before the next meeting.
- Pace Construction will be in the area and willing to camera the alley between Evans Tubman and Rhea Ave Flynn Ave.

Mayor Portra would like to discuss the parking of a semi in the wrong direction and on the wrong side of the street. The property owner was in attendance and he asked if the owner of the truck was notified. She indicated he was notified and he did not want to move the truck.

Mayor Portra indicated he would like to find out what it would cost to impound the truck and post it on the truck or hand it to the owner. Councilman Ross and Councilman Butikofer disagreed with the Mayor and will talk with the Truck Driver/Owner.
